TERROIR

It is the largest vineyard of the northern appellations, located in the Drôme, on the left bank of the Rhône. The appellation originally included only the city of Crozes-Hermitage and later extended to the neighboring cities. The vineyard is thus in its southern part, more recent than that of the Hermitage.

WINEMAKING

Alcoholic fermentation and controlled temperatures.

TASTING



Appearance : deep garnet-red almost black

Nose: notes of wood, black fruits.

Palate: smooth and balanced. It shows the typicity of the terroir, lots of freshness, and flavours of black fruits.



SERVICE

Serving temperature: between 14 and 16°C.

To be served with cold meats, poultry, roasted meats.
